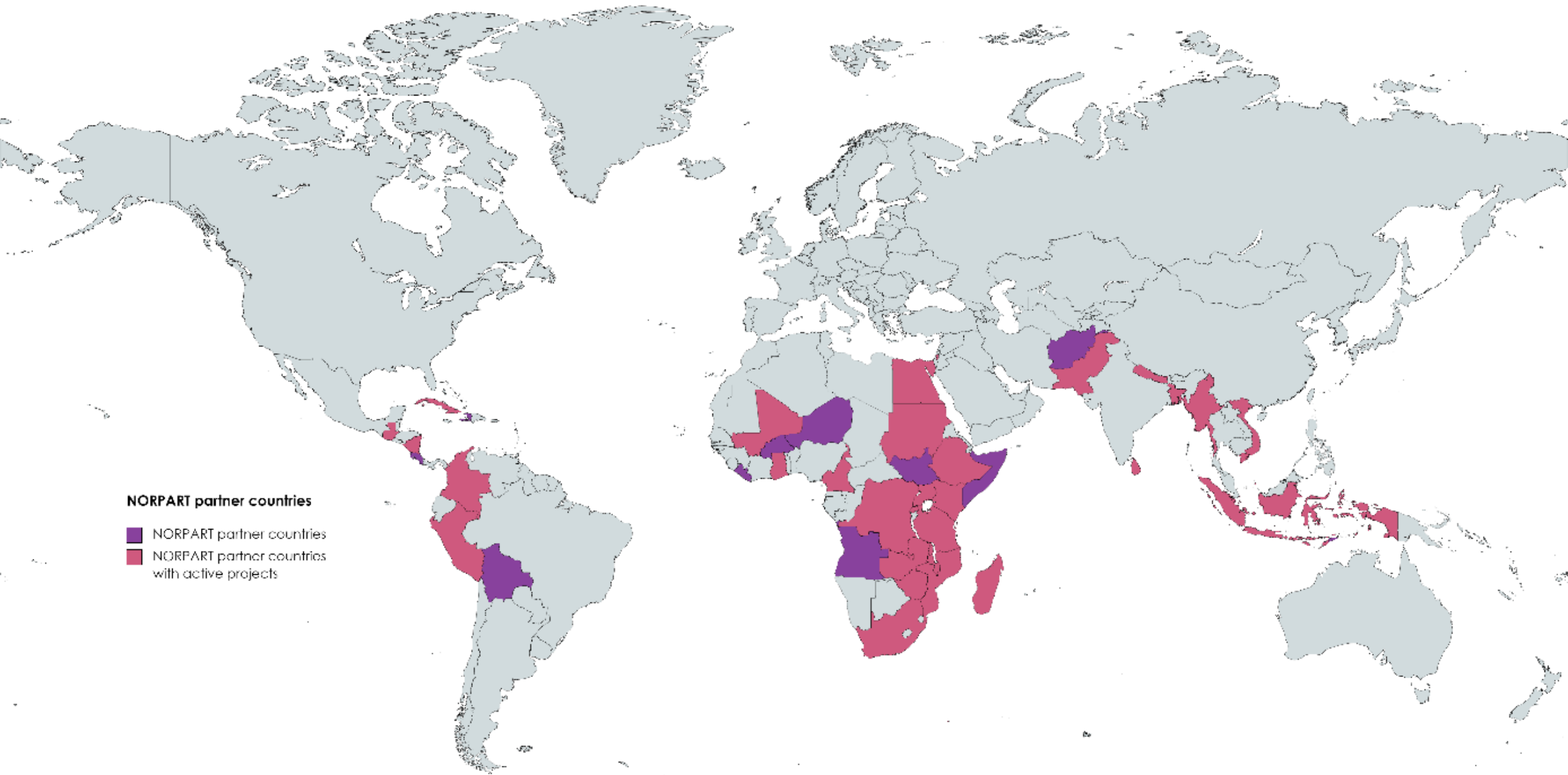
NORPART: A partnership model

The overall aim of NORPART is to contribute towards *enhancing the quality of higher education in Norway and partner countries*, through academic cooperation and mutual student mobility.



- NORPART encourages the institutions to build strong, mutually beneficial partnerships
- Target groups: higher education institutions in Norway and the Global South
- Partners from 40 defined partner countries are eligible for funding
- Current portfolio: 74 projects in 31 different countries, 16 Norwegian institutions are involved
- Jointly funded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education and Research

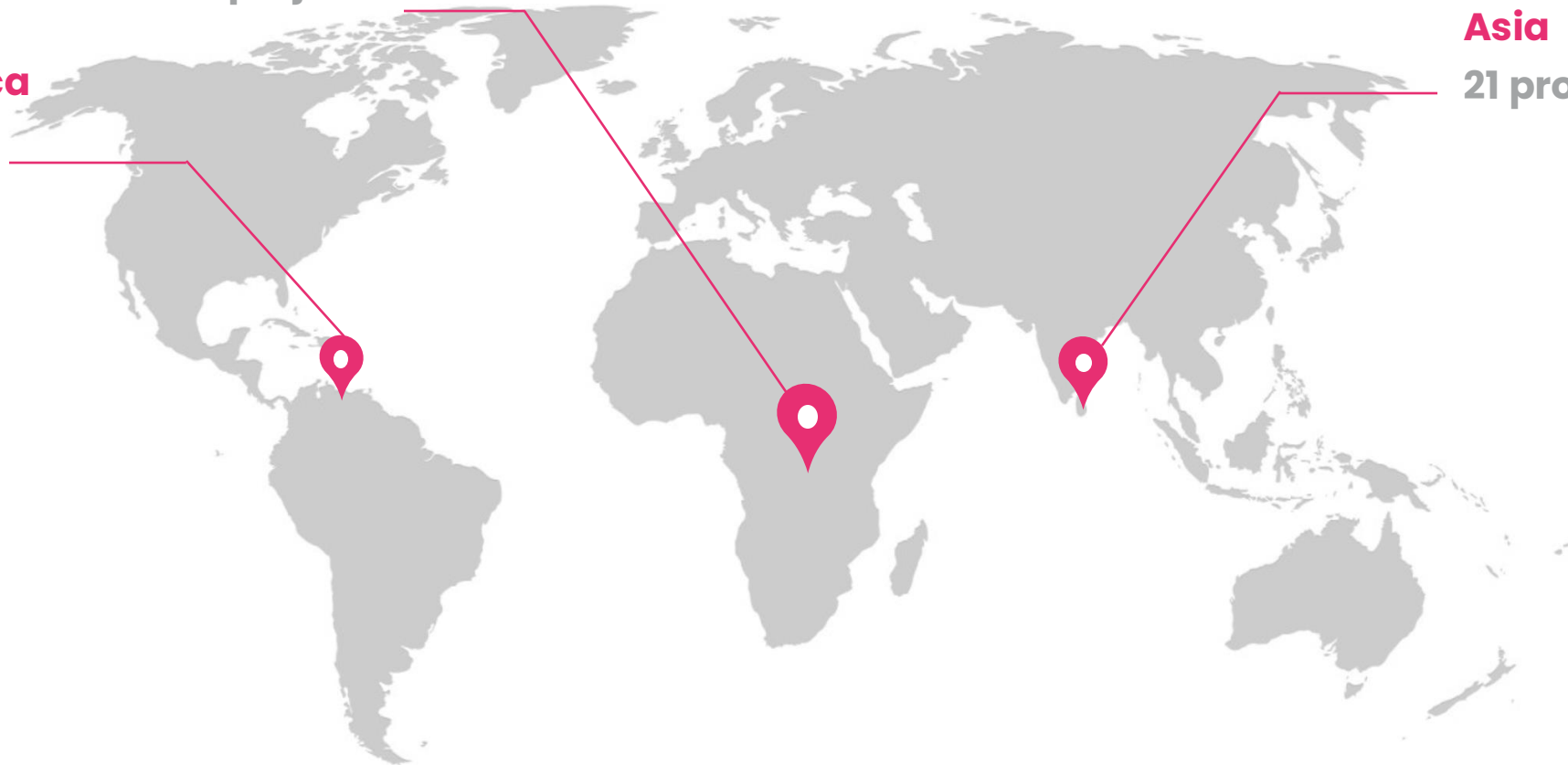

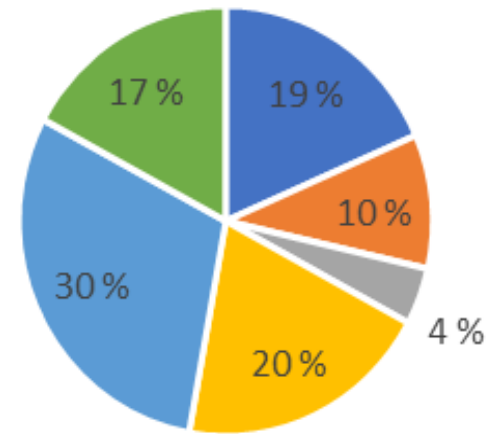

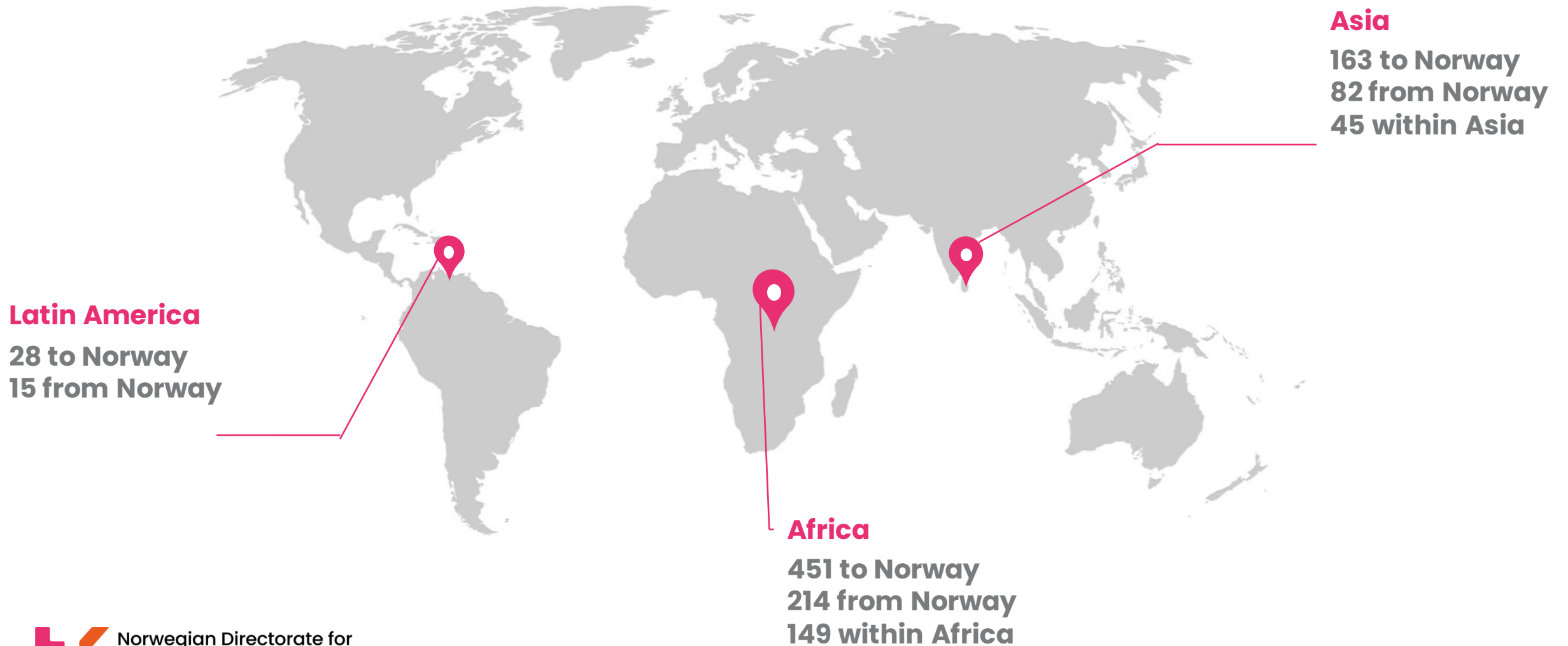
NORPART Academic disciplines

NORPART student mobilities 2017-21

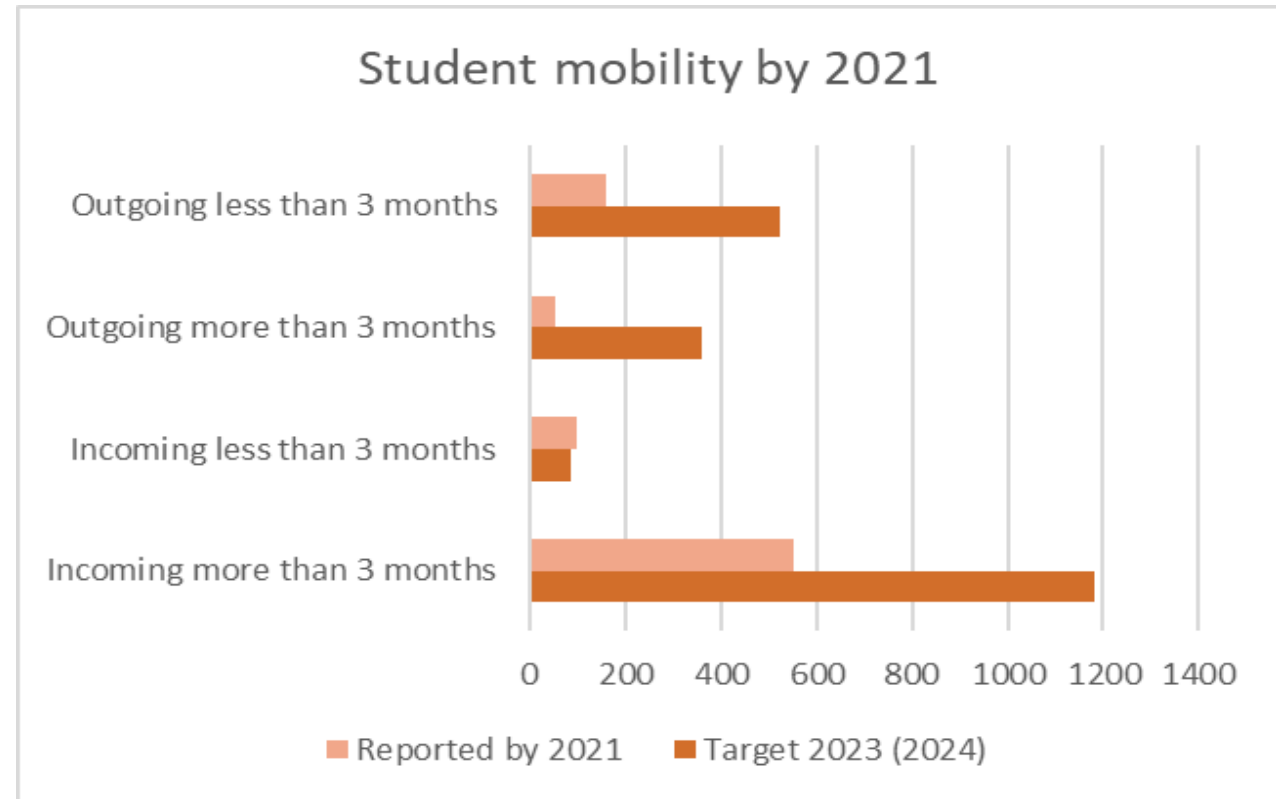
